Eat This

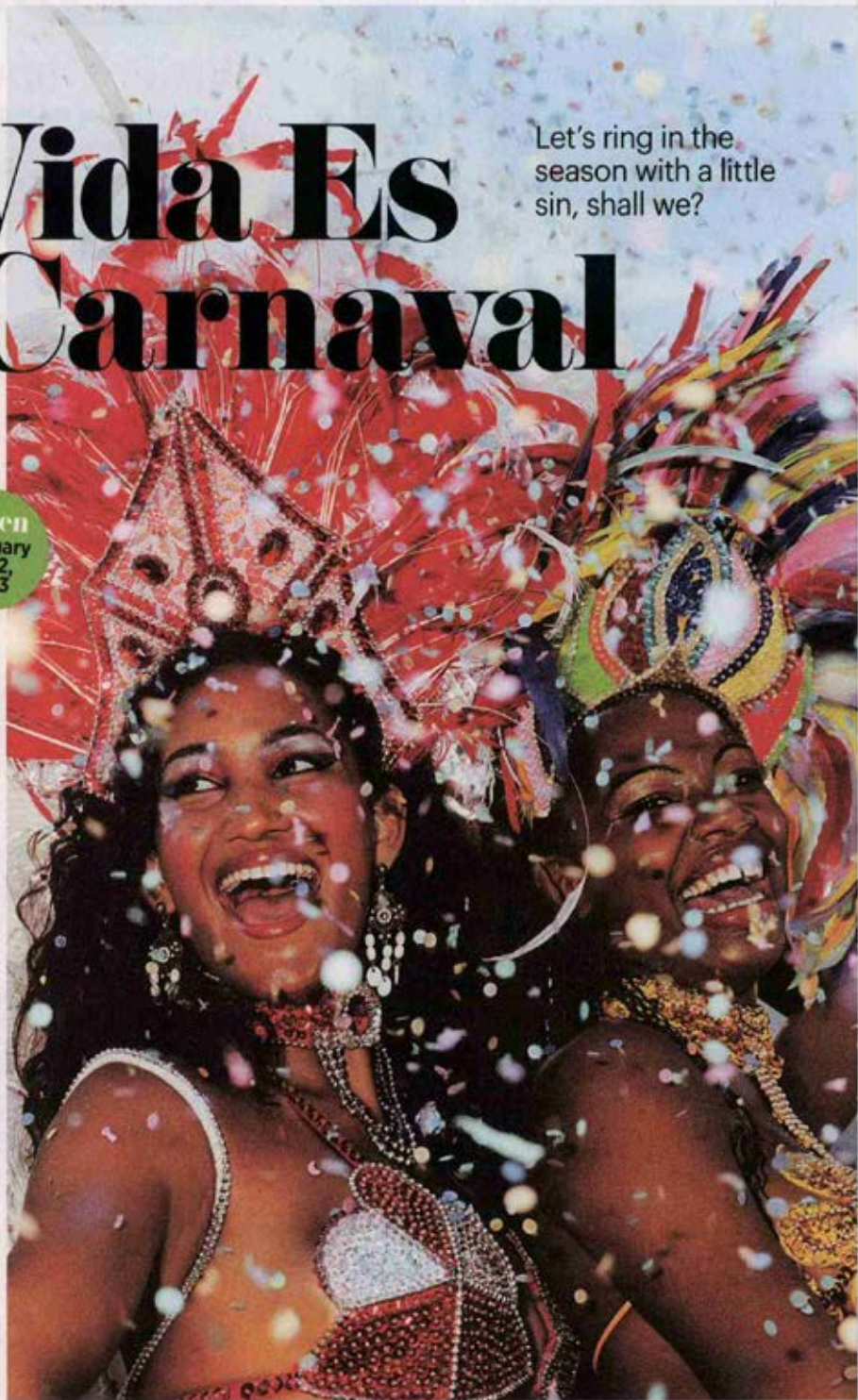
Trini-style roti from the Patraj shop is a must.
