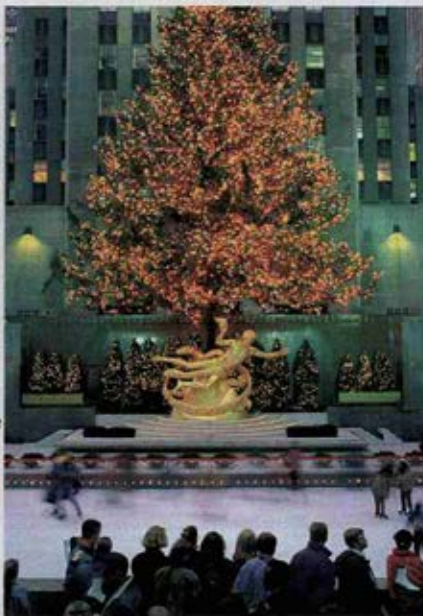


LOS ANGELES

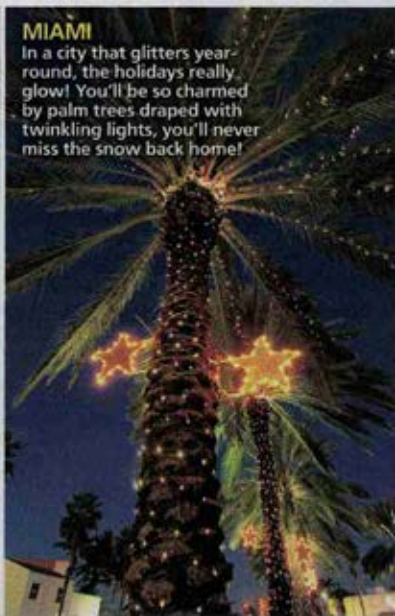
NEW YORK CITY

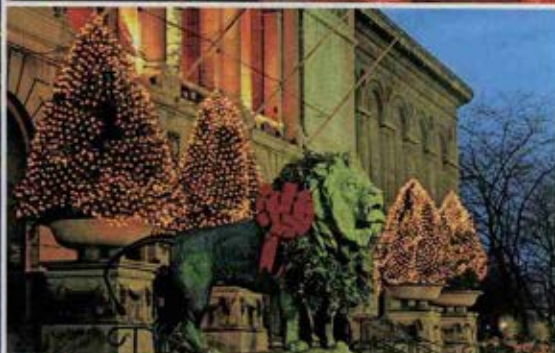
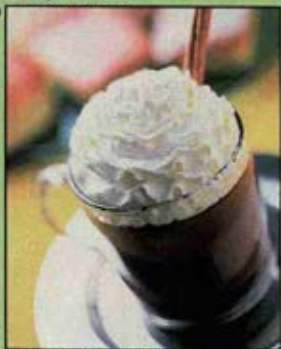
Warm up with a New York hot-chocolate cocktail!
